The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, October 8, 1984, with Commissioners Norris, Mansfield and Rohrer present.

DISCUSSION - IMPLEMENTATION OF DWI ADJUDICATION GRANT

The following city representatives were present for this discussion: Jim Rice, City of Anacortes; Steve Mansfield, City of Anacortes; Stan Kersey, City of Burlington; and Lyn Smith, City of Mount Vernon.

Mike Woodmansee, Skagit County Budget and Finance Director, pointed out two important aspects of the DWI Impact Grant implementation: (1) Deciding upon how to pay the cities their share of the DWI Grant proceeds, and (2) Establishing a policy for determining which DWI cases are eligible for DWI Impact funds and monitoring the prosecution results.

Discussion followed regarding Judge Eugene Anderson's Draft Policy Statement for the use of the funds. Steve Mansfield, of the City of Anacortes, pointed out the importance of identifying the cases to be tried using the grant funds, to avoid supplanting of funds.

Tom Moser, Prosecuting Attorney, stated that he spoke with Jack O'Connell, Director of OFM Grant Projects, who felt the County should not impose any regulations or guidelines on the grant's implementation. He stated that the County and cities are not going to be supplanting funds, in that people will not be fired in order to hire new people with the grant money.

The Board appreciated the concerns of those present in order to prevent supplanting of funds, but felt they did not want to become involved in the implementation of regulations and guidelines.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

The following miscellaneous items were addressed:

1. Commissioner Mansfield motioned to approve the Record of the Board's Proceedings for Tuesday, October 2, 1984. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.
2. Commissioner Mansfield motioned to schedule seven Planning Commission referred items, as identified in a memo dated October 2, 1984, for 10:30 a.m., Monday, October 15, 1984. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.
3. Commissioner Mansfield motioned to schedule another Planning Commission referred item, the Kenart & Associates proposed development, for 1:30 p.m., Monday, October 15, 1984. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.
4. The Board approved for signature contracts with Anacortes Community Health Council and Skagit Counseling & Psychiatric Services for providing local Substance Abuse Prevention/Early Intervention Program services for the period beginning September 1, 1984, and ending June 30, 1985, as recommended by JoAnn Angevine, Community Services Coordinator.
5. The Board approved for signature a contract with Community Homewell, Inc., for providing foot care services to senior citizens. The cost of \$7 per client will be paid by the client, as the County is simply furnishing locations for the service.

PROCLAMATION - SKAGIT COUNTY 4-H WEEK, OCTOBER 7 - 13, 1984.

Dorothy Stevens, Outgoing President of Skagit County's 4-H, told of past projects and accomplishments. She thanked the Board for their continued support.

Commissioner Mansfield motioned to adopt the resolution proclaiming the week of October 7 through October 13, 1984, as Skagit County 4-H Week. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously. (Resolution #10215)


ADJOURNMENT


Commissioner Mansfield motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.
