3:00 p.m. MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Thursday, March 7, 1985, with Commissioners Vaux and Walberg present. Commissioner Rohrer was absent.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

1. Commissioner Walberg motioned to approve a Taxpayer's Claim for Reduction of Assessments on Destroyed Real or Personal Property for Earle M. Smith, 3564 Highway 20, Concrete, Washington 98237, in the amount of \$5,180 for tax year 1985 because of EDB contamination. Chairman Vaux seconded the motion, as recommended by the Assessor. The motion was carried and so ordered. (#627)
2. Commissioner Walberg motioned to approve a Petition for Property Tax Refund for Olaf A. Olsen, 2214 Highway 8, Mount Vernon, Washington, 98273, in the amount of \$222.06, because of senior citizen exemption. Chairman Vaux seconded the motion, as recommended by the Assessor and Treasurer. The motion was carried and so ordered.
3. Commissioner Walberg motioned to approve Warrants #1147 through #1235 in the amount of \$78,825.27. Chairman Vaux seconded the motion. The motion was carried and so ordered. (C-11)
4. Vernon Egbers, Fair Manager, was present to request the Board sign a Washington State Fund for Agricultural Fairs Application for Special Assistance Grant. He explained that the application was requesting \$7,491 to be combined with \$11,200 of County matching funds already budgeted in the Skagit County Fair Fund. The funds will be used to construct bleachers; poultry, rabbit and cat cages and feeders; fencing for the horse arena; and gate improvements.



Commissioner Walberg motioned to approve the signing of the Application for Special Assistance Grant for the above listed projects. Chairman Vaux seconded the motion. The motion was carried and so ordered.


ADJOURNMENT

Commissioner Walberg motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Chairman Vaux seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.


