The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, July 17, 1985, with Commissioners Vaux and Walberg present. Commissioner Rohrer was absent.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

The following miscellaneous items were addressed:

1. Jay Ensley, Assistant Director of the Public Works Department, presented the bid recommendation for the Inman Landfill expansion project to the Board. After a review of all bids received, the Public Works Department recommended the bid be awarded to Humphrey Construction, Inc., of Woodinville, Washington, for their bid of \$438,900. Mr. Ensley stated that Humphrey Construction has had 44 comparable projects and the consultant felt very good about this company.

Commissioner Walberg motioned to adopt the resolution awarding the bid for the Inman Landfill expansion project to the lowest bidder, Humphrey Construction, Inc., for the total amount of \$438,900. Chairman Vaux seconded the motion. The motion was carried and so ordered. (Resolution #10556)

2. Commissioner Walberg motioned to approve the Petition for Property Tax Refund for Raymond L. Enger, 820 Marshall, Sedro Woolley, Washington 98284, in the amount of \$26.99, due to senior citizen exemption. Chairman Vaux seconded the motion, as recommended by the Skagit County Assessor and Treasurer. The motion was carried and so ordered. (#851116)
3. Commissioner Walberg motioned to approve the Petition for Property Tax Refund for Robert F. Smith, 1311 East Division, Mount Vernon, Washington 98273, in the amount of \$22.43, because the property was deeded to the University of Washington and is therefore exempt from taxes. Chairman Vaux seconded the motion, as recommended by the Skagit County Assessor and Treasurer. The motion was carried and so ordered. (#850980)


ADJOURNMENT



