MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, March 25, 1986, with Commissioners Rohrer, Vaux and Walberg present.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

1. The Board approved for signature the Department of Ecology Contract Amendment #3, which extends the date for completion of the review of the Solid Waste Management Plan from April 30, to August 31, 1986.
2. The Board approved for signature the Department of Ecology solid waste grant in the amount of \$7,065,773 for construction of the incineration facility.


