The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in special session on Wednesday, April 23, 1986, with Commissioners Vaux and Walberg present. Commissioner Rohrer was absent.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

1. Commissioner Vaux motioned to approve an out-of-state travel request for Paula Kvam, of the Clerk's Office, to attend the Association for Information & Image Management workshop in San Francisco, California, from May 11, through May 16, 1986, in order to obtain education and training in micrographics fundamentals which will assist in the implementation and management of the microfilming of the Clerk's records. Commissioner Walberg seconded the motion. The motion was carried and so ordered.
2. Vouchers audited and certified by the auditing officer as required by R.C.W. 42.24.080, and those expense reimbursement claims certified as required by R.C.W. 42.24.090, have been recorded on a listing which has been made available to the Board.



3. Commissioner Walberg motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Commissioner Vaux seconded the motion. The motion was carried and so ordered.






W. W. Vaux, Commissioner
