MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, May 21, 1986, with Commissioners Rohrer, Vaux and Walberg present.

TRAFFIC SAFETY AWARDS PRESENTATION.

Jeff Monsen, Traffic Safety Engineer, noted that this awards presentation was in conjunction with Traffic Safety Awareness Week. He informed the Board that they have noticed an increase in accidents this past year, however there has been fewer traffic fatalities, fewer alcohol related accidents, and greater safety belt usage.

In recognition of community leadership in traffic safety, the Board of Commissioners presented recognition plaques to the following:

#### MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS


1. In accordance with action previously taken, the Board approved for signature the Nub Poppe Rezone Request #R-86-004 with modification. (Resolution #10859)

Commissioner Walberg motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Commissioner Vaux seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.


