The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, September 16, 1986, with Commissioners Rohrer, Vaux and Walberg present.

DISCUSSION - COURTHOUSE SIGNS - Ruth Wylie, County Treasurer.

County Treasurer Ruth Wylie informed the Board of the need for additional directory signs in the Courthouse Complex. She presented the Commissioners with a list of most frequently asked questions answered by her staff.

Suggested improvements included:

1. Information desk manned by a volunteer to direct people to the proper location.
2. Maps with complete diagram of the various buildings and "you are here" indicator.

The Board thanked Mrs. Wylie for these suggestions and will investigate the matter further.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

1. Gene Sampley, Director of the Public Works Department, submitted to the Board the 1987 recommended Annual Road Program. He noted that the program must be adopted prior to the adoption of the final road program. Work sessions will be scheduled in the near future.
2. Gene Sampley opened a package received from C. & H. Waste Energy, Inc., one of the proposers who submitted a proposal yesterday for the resource recovery facility. The package contained several pieces of literature which were not included in several of the proposal packages received yesterday. Mr. Sampley noted that the information received was not critical to the proposal, and was for information only.
3. Louie Parker, of Lyman, was present to request the Board consider adopting an ordinance regarding pitbulls.

The Board will contact Snohomish County and King County for copies of their ordinances regarding this matter.

4. Cathy Johnson of Conway, Lillian Brown of Sedro Woolley, and Rich Borman of Mount Vernon, explained the purpose of the International Day of Peace.

Commissioner Vaux read the proclamation designating Tuesday, September 16, 1986, as "International Day of Peace" in Skagit County.

ADJOURNMENT


Commissioner Walberg motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Commissioner Vaux seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.
