The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, October 7, 1986, with Commissioners Rohrer, Vaux and Walberg present.

DISCUSSION - COUNTY APPRAISER PARKING - AL STEWART, CHIEF APPRAISER.

Al Stewart, Chief Appraiser, requested the Board provide free parking in a County parking lot for the six appraisers to use on their days in the field. Mr. Stewart explained that much time is wasted when the appraisers come into the office from the field because they have to drive around looking for a parking place on the street and then walk long distances carrying field books, etc. Since they use their personal cars for work, they do not feel they should have to pay the \$6 per month charged for other County employees. He noted that the appraisers would appreciate having County cars to drive during working hours.

Discussion followed regarding the possibility of allowing two or three parking spots free of charge for the appraisers.

Commissioner Walberg suggested charging them \$6 per month and finding them parking spaces as close to their office as possible.

Commissioner Vaux suggested the parking spaces be used as an incentive somehow.

Mr. Stewart requested three free parking spaces to be used by the six appraisers, since approximately half of each appraiser's time is spent in the field.

Commissioner Vaux explained that last year the appraisers' basic monthly allowance was raised from \$50 to \$75.

Commissioner Vaux motioned to provide two free parking spaces in one of the

County's gravel lots. Commissioner Walberg seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.

Bob Taylor, Administrative Officer, was instructed to provide two parking spaces in one of the gravel lots specifically designated for appraisers' parking.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

1. In accordance with action previously taken, the Board approved for signature a lease agreement with the Marblemount Cooperative Preschool for a period of one year, commencing on September 1, 1986, for the sum of \$1 per year.
2. Commissioner Vaux motioned to approve the following Petitions for Property Tax Refund, as recommended by the Skagit County Assessor and Treasurer:
  - a. Edgar H. Greiert, 1305 South 16th, Mount Vernon, Washington 98273, in the amount of \$22.35, due to senior citizen exemption. (#008686)
  - b. Earl Hanson, 2517 Riverbend Road, Mount Vernon, Washington 98273, in the amount of \$401.18, due to manifest error. (#008386)
  - c. Vincent Scott, 3548 Highway 20, Sedro-Woolley, Washington 98284, in the amount of \$1.19, due to reduced value ordered by the Board of Equalization (in E.D.B. area). (#005185)
  - d. Kenneth L. Laymon, 517 Kloshe Way, La Conner, Washington 98257, in the amount of \$154.60, due to senior citizen exemption. (#008586)
  - e. Timothy Martin, 9270 California Avenue S.W., Seattle, Washington 98136, due to cancellation per the Department of Revenue. (#006886)
  - f. Norbert Tiexmen in the amount of \$365.76, due to payment on wrong account. (#008786)

Commissioner Walberg seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.

3. Vouchers audited and certified by the auditing officer as required by R.C.W. 42.24.080, and those expense reimbursement claims certified as required by R.C.W. 42.24.090, have been recorded on a listing which has been made available to the Board.




ADJOURNMENT
