The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, March 3, 1987, with Commissioners Vaux, Walberg and Rohrer present.

ORIENTATION - COOPERATIVE EDUCATION STUDENTS

Bob Taylor, Administrative Officer, introduced four students from Skagit Valley College's Cooperative Education Program: Bianco Terado, who is working in the Commissioners' Office; Laurel Pigusch, who is working in the Auditor's Office; Arliss Marshall, who is working in the Treasurer's Office; and Jack Mc Dougle, who is working in the Parks, Recreation and Senior Services Department.

A brief discussion followed wherein the students and the Board interchanged questions and answers. The Board thanked the students and hoped their experience with the County would prove worthwhile.

CERTIFICATION OF COUNTY PROPERTY

Mike Woodmansee, Budget/Finance Director, presented the Board with the 1986 County Property Inventory Report. Mike stated the County's total personal property amounted to \$2,369,000.00. The Board thanked Mike for a job well done.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

The following miscellaneous items were addressed:

1. Commissioner Rohrer motioned to approve a resolution appointing Michael D. Bridgman, 1448 Bow Hill Road, Bow, WA 98232, as a Commissioner of Skagit County Cemetery Board of Commissioners, District No. 4. Commissioner Vaux seconded the motion. The motion was passed unanimously. Resolution #11153
2. Commissioner Rohrer motioned to approve the Record of the Proceedings for Monday, March 2, 1987. Commissioner Vaux seconded the motion. The motion was passed unanimously.

3. According to previous action taken, the Board signed a resolution regarding A Moratorium on Fish Net Pen Facilities. Resolution #11154
4. Commissioner Rohrer motioned to approve a Petition for Property Tax Refund for Kristie Lee based on an appeal made to the Board of Equalization as recommended by the County Assessor and County Treasurer for the amount of \$6.81. Petition #004385
5. Commissioner Rohrer motioned to approve the denial of a Taxpayer's Claim for Reduction of Assessments on Destroyed Real or Personal Property filed by Connie Daniel and Anita Glass, 6203 S. Montgomery, Tacoma, WA, as it was not filed properly per R.C.W. 84.70. Commissioner Vaux seconded the motion. The motion was passed unanimously. #743
6. The Board approved for signature four contracts from the Department of Social and Health Services, Division of Mental Health, adding \$5,425.00 to the current contract to cover the cost of purchasing computer equipment to be used by and housed at Skagit Community Mental Health Center, relating to data on tracking the whereabouts of chronically mentally ill adults who move between various state hospitals and community service centers.


ADJOURNMENT
