The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, April 22, 1987, with Commissioners Walberg, Vaux and Rohrer present.

CONTINUED PUBLIC HEARING - REQUEST OF PACIFIC QUARRIES FOR EXTENSION OF OPERATING HOURS.

The Board of Commissioners reconvened the Pacific Quarries public hearing at the quarry site.

Michael Brown, Manager of Pacific Quarries, showed those in attendance the rock crushing facilities in operation, the stockpiles of processed materials, improvements to erosion/sedimentation prevention facilities, and the quarry area.


The Board then toured the Linda Vista area to listen to the quarry operation and to visually inspect alleged damage to foundations and driveways of the residents in the area.
