The Board signed four contracts with the Department of Social and Health Services for the first quarter of the biennium based on last year's figures.

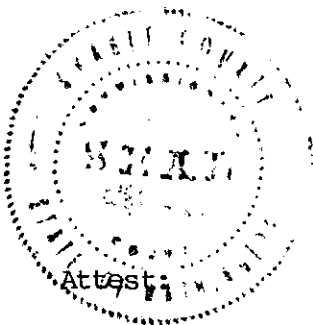
MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS
