SKAGIT COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

Wednesday, November 25, 1987

10:00 a.m. Continuation of Public Hearing - Skagit Systems Cooperative Shoreline Substantial Development Conditional Use Permit Request #SLCU-787, for the Construction and Operation of a Salmon Net Pen Facility in Skagit Bay.

Held at the Hope Island Inn, 1686 Chilberg Avenue, La Conner, WA

The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, November 25, 1987, with Commissioners Walberg, Vaux and Rohrer present.

The Board of County Commissioners met at the Hope Island Inn parking lot for a site tour of the proposed net pen facility. Since the proposed location measured .7 mile off shore the proposed site was viewed from the Hope Island Inn property.

Jim Gibson, Skagit Systems Cooperative (SSC) biologist briefly explained the location of the proposed net pen facility (as located by a 32' boat in the approximate location on the water) and its relationship to Hope Island and the surrounding shoreline areas. Mr. Gibson also pointed out an existing aquaculture net pen facility just to the north of Hope Island.

Lorraine Loomis, SCC, indicated the proposed beach landing site some 300 feet south of the Hope Island Inn.



ADJOURNMENT

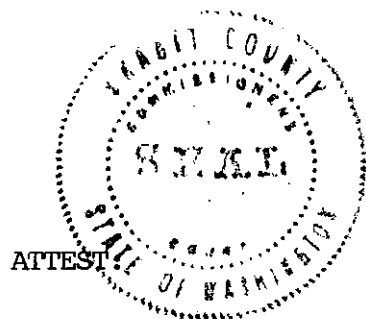
Commissioner Vaux motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.


