MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, September 7, 1988, with Commissioners Vaux, Rohrer and Walberg present.

Discussion and Signing of Microfilm Agreement with Whatcom County.

After receiving information from Paula Kvam, of Records Management, and Mike Woodmansee, Budget and Finance Director, the Board approved and signed an agreement between Whatcom County and Skagit County to provide microfilming services for Whatcom County at the fee of \$210.00 per box. The contract is effective September 1, 1988, and continues for eighteen months or until the filming is completed, whichever occurs first.

Discussion - Proposed Safety Improvements at Northern State Fair Site.

Jon Aarstad, Director of Parks and Recreation, gave the Board a proposed list of safety improvements to be completed in 1988. These improvements included facility signage and emergency hazardous condition repair (\$10,000), general cleanup to various buildings (\$5,000), and construction of Test Lake (\$3,500). The Board of Commissioners gave approval to Mr. Aarstad to proceed with these safety improvements.

1. Chairman Vaux moved to approve a property tax refund in the amount of \$134.81 for Mary Lou Frye, due to being an exempt party.
2. Commissioner Rohrer moved to approve the resolution awarding the bid for lease of pasture land at the proposed Skagit County Fairgrounds to James H. Posey for the amount of \$10.00 per acre per year and a bonus bid of \$2,657.00. Commissioner Walberg seconded. The motion carried and was so ordered. (Resolution 11735)
3. Jon Aarstad, Director of Parks and Recreation, gave the Board an update on the progress of the Burlington-Edison Regional Playfields construction.
