The Board thanked everyone for their participation.


MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS


ADJOURNMENT

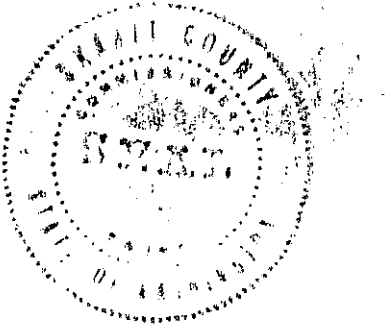


