The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, June 7, 1989, with Commissioners Dave Rohrer, Ruth Wylie and W. W. Vaux present.

PRESENTATION BY RANDY SCOTT OF WASHINGTON STATE ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES REGARDING NEW SOLID WASTE LEGISLATION.

Commissioner Vaux introduced Mr. Randy Scott as the Washington Association of Counties lobbyist for the Sprengle Bill (Substitute House Bill 1671) in early 1989. Commissioner Vaux stated that the Board has asked Mr. Scott to present a summary of the bill today, and to describe its ramifications.

Mr. Scott then gave information on Substitute House Bill 1671. He stated that it is the most extensive solid waste legislation passed in the last 10 to 12 years. He listed the following positive effects of the Bill:

- 1) Changes the term "solid waste" to apply uniformly throughout the statutes.
- 2) Clarifies the relationship between entities involved in solid waste management, i.e., the County's role as opposed to the State, cities and individual contractors.
- 3) It provides money for growth in the solid waste management staff and technical advisory staff at the Department of Ecology.

Mr. Scott then reviewed a number of key sections of the Bill and explained their purpose and intent. He provided a copy of the Bill to each Board member and audience member, as well as a section by section analysis compiled by the law firm of Heller, Ehrman, White and McAuliffe. Mr. Scott discussed with the Board such items as recycling plans, Solid Waste Management Plans, the Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) role in solid waste management, and source separation.

A question and answer period was then held with the audience, which included Mayor Raymond Reep from Mount Vernon, Stan Kersey representing the City of Burlington, members of the Public Works Department, and a number of private sanitation company representatives.

MISCELLANEOUS.

The Board approved for signature an Out-of-State Travel Request for Bob Lee of the Assessor's Office to travel to Hillsboro, Oregon, for the purpose of conducting an on-site evaluation of a computer software package for possible use by Skagit County.



Steve Klienbart requested that this item be postponed until a later date due to the inability of all parties involved to attend. The Board concurred.


ADJOURNMENT

Commissioner Wylie motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Commissioner Vaux seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.



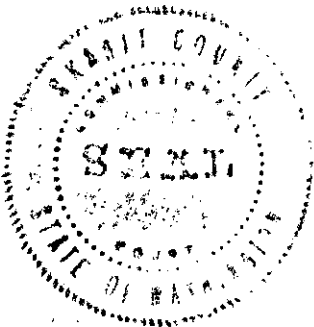


