MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS.

The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, February 6, 1990 with Commissioners Dave Rohrer and Ruth Wylie present. Commissioner Vaux' absence was excused.

PLANNING DEPARTMENT ITEMS

Scott Kirkpatrick, Director, Planning and Community Development reported as follows:

- 1) Plans Examiner Barbara Wilding has resigned as of March 1, 1990. They will be advertising for this position starting this week.
- 2) The board expressed some concern about the need to speed up the permit process. Mr. Kirkpatrick advised that they are working on this and have recently talked to the industry about the possibility of issuing a demolition permit for remodels. They will probably begin doing this in a couple of weeks, after they have looked at some of the models other jurisdictions are using. This should reduce the amount of plans review done in-house for those kinds of jobs.
- 3) Mr. Kirkpatrick advised that he will be attending a meeting this afternoon with the Skagitonians, the Ag Coordinating Council, the Port of Skagit and suppliers to discuss an industrial park concept for Skagit County.
- 4) The Planning Commission will have their annual meeting on Tuesday, February 13. They will discuss the County infra-structure. Members of the farm community and the Farm Bureau will be present to discuss such issues as current legislation that could have an effect on the community, etc. Mr. Kirkpatrick invited the commissioners for lunch or to attend any of the sessions.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

- 1) An Agreement between the Economic Development Association of Skagit County and Skagit County was approved for signature.
- 2) Commissioner Rohrer motioned to approve the Out-of-State Travel Requests for Chairman Wylie, Robert W. Taylor and David Fleming to travel to Portland, Oregon to attend the Washington/Oregon Chapters "PRIMA" Conference on Risk Management April 8-11, 1990. Chairman Wylie seconded the motion which carried and was so ordered.


ADJOURNMENT

Commissioner Rohrer motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Chairman Wylie seconded the motion. The motion was carried and so ordered.


