The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, September 26, 1990, with Commissioners Ruth Wylie and W. W. Vaux. Commissioner Rohrer's absence was excused.

**PUBLIC HEARING - SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET - \$26,000 TO PARKS AND RECREATION FUND #114.**

Chairman Wylie waived the reading of the notice of public hearing, as published in The Skagit Argus.

Mike Woodmansee, Budget/Finance Direct, presented the resolution.

There being no public comment, Commissioner Vaux motioned to close the public hearing. Commissioner Wylie seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Commissioner Vaux then motioned to adopt the resolution authorizing a supplement budget in the amount of \$26,000 in interfund transfers to the Parks and Recreation Department Fund #114. Commissioner Wylie seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. (Resolution #12669)

**PUBLIC HEARING - SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET - \$854,450 TO THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND #001.**

Chairman Wylie waived the reading of the notice of public hearing, as published in The Skagit Argus.

Mike Woodmansee, Budget/Finance Direct, presented the resolution.

There being no public comment, Commissioner Vaux motioned to close the public hearing. Commissioner Wylie seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Commissioner Vaux then motioned to adopt the resolution authorizing a supplement budget in the amount of \$854,450 in unanticipated revenues from services fees, taxes and forest related revenues to the Current Expense Fund #001. Commissioner Wylie seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. (Resolution #12670)

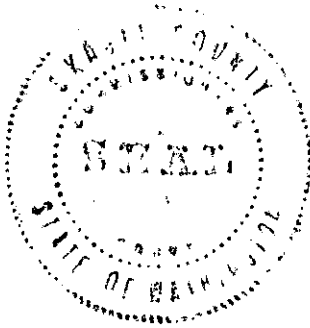
**MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS.**


Commissioner Vaux motioned to adopt the resolution authorizing a Budget Line Item Change in the amount of \$610,000 within the Solid Waste Operating Fund #401, in order to account for expenditures made during the County's take over of the operation of the incinerator from the contractor. Commissioner Wylie seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. (Resolution #12671)

**ADJOURNMENT:**


Commissioner Vaux motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Commissioner Wylie seconded the motion. The motion carried and was so ordered.
