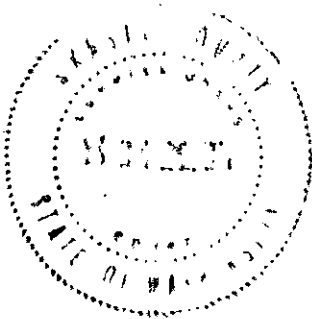
The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in an emergency session on Wednesday, November 28, 1990, to consider matters pertaining to the payment of sources for flood disaster work.


- A. Commissioner Vaux motioned to adopt a resolution presented by Mike Woodmansee, Budget/Finance Director, which authorizes a budget line item change in the amount of \$299,500 from the Land Acquisition and Facility Improvement Funds to various funds within the Current Expense Fund so that payment of debts incurred during the flood fight can be affected now, and a budget amendment approved at a later date. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. (Resolution #12726)
- B. Commissioner Vaux motioned to approve manual warrants #MW61969 through #MW61970 in the amount of \$127,700 to pay the Army Corps of Engineers and the Mount Vernon Post Office. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. (Transmittal No. C53-90)

ADJOURNMENT:

Commissioner Vaux motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Commissioner Rohrer seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.


