Friday, December 28, 1990

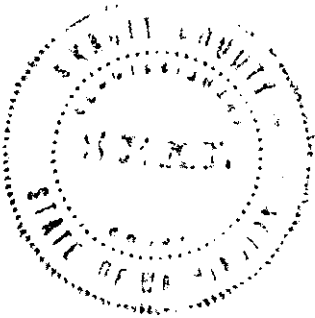
The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in an emergency session on Friday, December 28, 1990, with Commissioners Ruth Wylie and W. W. Vaux present. The purpose of the session was to consider a resolution declaring an emergency situation due to the Arctic cold front which visited Skagit County during the night.

Commissioner Vaux motioned to adopt the resolution declaring an emergency effective Friday, December 28, 1990, beginning at 6:00 a.m., due to the cold temperatures, snows, and high winds which caused power outages, downed trees, the shut down of the Guemes Ferry, and road closures. Chairman Wylie seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. (Resolution #12777)

ADJOURNMENT:

Commissioner Vaux motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Chairman Wylie seconded the motion. The motion was carried and was so ordered.


