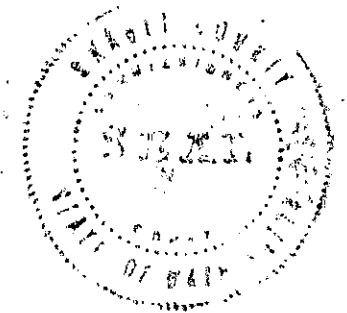
The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in an emergency session on Monday, December 31, 1990, to consider a resolution which would allow participation in the amount of \$10,000 on behalf of the Sedro Woolley Flood Zone for a drainage pump station installed as part of the development of Mountain View Estates. The developers portion of the costs would be \$14,886.88. The drainage improvement would benefit the area north of John Liner Road, which has suffered a drainage problem for several years. Consideration of this resolution prior to the end of the year would cause funds to be used from the 1990 budget, rather than the 1991 budget. Commissioners Ruth Wylie and Dave Rohrer were present for this item.

Commissioner Rohrer motioned to adopt the resolution authorizing an expenditure of \$10,000 on behalf of the Sedro Woolley Flood Control Zone as their portion of the costs of the installation of a pumping station at John Liner Road in Sedro Woolley. Chairman Wylie seconded the motion, which carried and was so ordered. (Resolution #12778)

ADJOURNMENT:

Commissioner Rohrer motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Chairman Wylie seconded the motion. The motion was carried and was so ordered.


