SKAGIT COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

Thursday, February 28, 1991

The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in an emergency session to consider a resolution to close North Texas Road #1780 because of the oil spill at the Texaco Refinery.

Commissioner Robinson motioned to adopt the resolution closing North Texas Road #1780 at the railroad tracks at March's Point Road to General Chemical Co. from 7:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 28, 1991, through 8:00 p.m. on Friday, March 1, 1991 to open cut the road and install a culvert to divert rain-water from running into the area contaminated by oil from the Texaco Oil Spill. Commissioner Wylie seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. (Resolution # 12870)

ADJOURNMENT:

Commissioner Wylie motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Commissioner Robinson seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.
