The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on with Commissioners Robby Robinson, Ruth Wylie, and W. W. Vaux present.

**PLANNING DEPARTMENT - SCOTT KIRKPATRICK, DIRECTOR.**

1.     Discussion - Skagit County Code 14.04.190(14) Amendment Redraft.

Mr. Kirkpatrick reviewed the changes that were requested by the Board on the Amendment redraft to SCC 14.04.190. The Board agreed that the necessary changes were made and requested that an ordinance be submitted for their adoption the following week.

2.     Code Enforcement Report.

The Code Enforcement Report was presented to the Board.

3.     Miscellaneous.

Gary Christensen stated that the Comprehensive Plan Element public meetings have been scheduled. The first meeting was in Concrete on September 21, 1992, for the overview of pertinent issues of the elements, and to answer questions of attendees. There was estimated to be 25 people in attendance, all of whom were informed and interested. The next meeting was scheduled for September 23, 1992, in Mount Vernon, and another on September 30, 1992, at the Fidalgo Elementary School in Anacortes.

Mr. Christensen submitted a memo from Kraig Olason regarding a request from the City of Anacortes for city officials or staff to participate in citizen advisory committees on element development and review during study sessions with the County's Planning Commission. Mr. Olason's memo suggested that the cities should be invited to participate after the CAC's have completed their work and forwarded a draft element to the Planning Commission for review and public hearing.

Mr. Kirkpatrick stated that the cities can be accommodated in several ways, and encouraged to participate other than in the CAC's.

**PROCLAMATION - SEA ISLAND SOUND CHORUS - BARBERSHOP HARMONY AWARENESS WEEK, SEPTEMBER 27, THROUGH OCTOBER 3, 1992.**

**UPDATE - LIVESTOCK AND WATER QUALITY PROGRAM, WSU COOPERATIVE EXTENSION.**

Kay Haaland, Mike Hacket, and Shirley Park, Cooperative Extension, reviewed with the Board the Annual Report on Livestock Educational Efforts. Throughout July, 1991, workshops were conducted regarding Strategic Ranch Management, Skagit County Teen Livestock Advisor, and a Cattlemen's Association Decision-Makers' Tour. In August, 1991, at the Skagit County Fair there was a Livestock Master Volunteer Program Display. January 1992, Livestock Mater Program statistics were gathered, and WSU Cattlemen's Winterschool was held with 350 in attendance. During April and May, 1992, WSU Water Quality advisors were trained and certified. June, 1992, WSU Water Quality Advisors began planning fall workshops. July 1992, a presentation was made to EPA regarding the Water Quality Advisor Program. August, 1992, a presentation was made to WSU State Extension Faculty about Water Quality Advisor Program, and a Livestock Master & Water Quality Advisors display was at the Skagit County Fair. September, 1992, interviewing and screening for Livestock Master program began. In October 1992, Livestock Mater Program training will begin and a workshop - "Farming: Looking to the Future" will be held.

**DECISION - ORDINANCE PROHIBITING JET SKIS ON CLEAR LAKE.**

Chairman Robinson stated that opinions were presented last week from Clear Lake residents regarding the use of jet skis. The lake is small and there is more congestion on the lake each year. Having seen the operation of the jet skis on the lake and after hearing the testimony of the residents, Chairman Robinson motioned to adopt the ordinance prohibiting jet skis on Clear Lake.

Commissioner Vaux seconded the motion, which carried unanimously. (Ordinance #14490).
