The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, October 28, 1992, with Commissioners Robby Robinson, W. W. Vaux and Ruth Wylie present.

PRESENTATION - ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS - FLOOD AWARENESS WEEK.

Dave Brookings, Flood Control Engineer, explained that each year during the annual flood awareness week, the Skagit County Public Works Department reviews their flood preparedness. Each year a meeting is held where the public can learn about flood preparedness and flood planning that is occurring in Skagit County. Mr. Brookings reviewed the agenda for this year's meeting.

Mr. Brookings reviewed training for staff, as well as for dike and drainage district commissioners and employees, that is occurring in conjunction with Flood Awareness Week. Inspections of levy and dike systems will also occur, a "flood fight exercise" is planned, and a sandbagging demonstration.

Corps representatives Bob Newbell, Ernie Sabo, Jeri Arbios, and Dick Burnam, and Diane Fitzpatrick, Emergency Management, and Les Miller, Emergency Management, Portland District, were introduced to the Board.

Ernie Sabo and Bob Newbell spoke briefly on the activities planned for flood awareness week.
