The Board thanked the bidders and Staff advised those present that a decision concerning the bid award would be made by the end of the week.

MISCELLANEOUS.

Audrey Smith from the Tulip Festival introduced to the Board Mark Kramer, who is handling the Tulip Transit part of the festival. Mr. Kramer advised that since Tulip Transit began April 1, there have been five different schedule revisions and three route revisions to try to keep the targeted 20 minute intervals in peak periods. Mr. Kramer reviewed a map with the Board showing the route of Tulip Transit. Commissioner Hart indicated that gridlock was in evidence this past weekend, with a huge volume of people out trying to see the tulip fields. The roads cannot handle any more traffic at this time. Mr. Kramer is proposing putting up a manned barricade at Bradshaw Road allowing the buses, and local residents access. Ms. Smith also stated there would need to be increased signage to notify the public of the route closure.

The Board indicated their approval of this plan.

ADJOURNMENT:

Commissioner Robinson motioned to adjourn the proceedings. Commissioner Hart seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.
