John Abenroth, Public Works Staff, opened the nine bids received as follows;

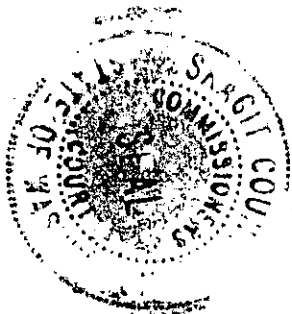
1. Diobsud Creek Construction - \$74,575.05

8. Northfork Construction - \$65,716.25
9. Shoreline Construction Co. - \$95,562.00

Shine Enterprises withdrew their bid at the conclusion of the bid opening. Mr. Abenroth stated that the bids would be reviewed and a determination made within two weeks.
