The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, February 23, 1999, with Commissioners Ted W. Anderson, Harvey Wolden and Robert Hart present.

**PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT – Chal Martin, Director.**

1. Discussion – Part-Time Ferry Manager Position.

Chal Martin, Director, asked for authorization to advertise for a part-time Ferry Manager position.

Commissioner Wolden commented on the history of the privatization of the Guemes Ferry, and the adherent pressures on Charlie Tewalt, Ferry Manager. He suggested that perhaps a second in command to Mr. Tewalt as a road supervisor would be a better solution.

Mr. Martin talked about a Grade 26 half-time position costing between \$30,000 to \$36,000 per year (including benefits). He expressed the desire to advertise for this position to see what caliber of response would be received.

Chairman Anderson stated that District 3 is the most remote district, and the logistics to the Guemes Ferry make covering both assignments difficult.

Commissioner Wolden asked about moving Andy Shaw to special ops and giving him some of the responsibility for the ferry operation. He stated that he is reluctant to accept the fact that another position is needed.

Mr. Martin explained that this position would eventually disappear with the privatization of the ferry operation. He stated that the Public Employee Relations Commission has given the County a roadmap to proceed in this regard. He stated that such privatization has been discussed with the union, and should move forward to be completed within a year's time. He stated that, in the meantime, we have an awkward situation with covering these two sets of diverse duties.

Commissioner Hart stated that the biggest difficulty is not the actual operation of the ferry, whether under County or private company control, but the amount of administrative time spent in both the Public Works Directors' and County Commissioners' office. He stated that the ferry serves the public well, and is well maintained. Commissioner Hart indicated that rather than looking for a part-time manager, perhaps the Department should try to get a handle on what kind of organizational structure is needed.

Chairman Anderson spoke to the fairness and equality issues concerning this one employee and that it is too much to ask him to continue to cover both of these positions. He commented that it is time to deliver some relief in this regard.

Commissioner Wolden asked if there would be an increased fare structure to pay for this part-time position. Mr. Martin answered that this is not the case, that there is no anticipated fare increase. He explained that asking Mr. Shaw to share some of these duties has been considered and that there is a range of other options to be considered. He stated that it is the Department's intent to absorb these costs with other organizational changes.

Mr. Martin further explained that advertising for a position does not mean that someone will be hired. He stated that he is simply asking for the authorization to advertise for this position.

A discussion ensued on different possibilities and scenarios that would resolve this situation.

Following this discussion, Commissioner Hart indicated that he is comfortable advertising for this position to see what interest it would generate, but that he is not comfortable in authorizing such a position at this time. Commissioners Wolden and Anderson concurred.

2. Miscellaneous.

The damages and repairs necessary to the Sinclair Island dock were briefly discussed.

**PLANNING & PERMIT CENTER – Tom Karsh, Director.**

1. Signature – Letter of Interest for Community Development Block Grant Funding.

Corey Schmidt, Building Official, spoke regarding additional funds being requested for CDBG funding. The Board signed a letter of interest to CTED for such additional funding.

2. Re-Evaluation of Citizen Advisory Committees (CACs) for:

- (a) ESB 6094 Amendments to the Growth Management Act; and
- (b) Secondary Forest-NRL Designation Criteria.

Gary Christensen, Assistant Director, reviewed a memorandum regarding these two citizen advisory committees (CACs) to assist the Department with addressing the ESB 6094 Amendments and Secondary Forest-NRL Designation Criteria. He advised that there were two public service announcements in December and again in January, and, as a result, the Department received a number of submittals. There were 12 citizen submittals indicating an interest to serve on ESB 6094 and six to participate on re-evaluation of Secondary Forest-NRL Designation Criteria. Mr. Christensen stated that the Department has found over the years in working with CACs that the prime number of members for these committees is 6-12 individuals.

Mr. Christensen suggested that the Department would suggest, after reviewing the list with the Board, that the Department would prepare a resolution which would officially appoint the members to these CACs as directed by the Board. The Resolution would also define the roles and timelines for each committee.

A discussion ensued regarding the duties of the committee, and the proposed members for the CACs.

Commissioner Wolden suggested getting someone from a school district so as to get expertise from that side of the ledger. Chairman Anderson suggested talking to Mike Casey, Superintendent of Sedro Woolley Schools, or Carl Bruner.

The Department advised they would prepare the necessary Resolution for the Board's consideration within the next two weeks.

3. Miscellaneous.

- A. Mr. Christensen advised that a DNS for Section 7.1 of Resolution No. 16559 which deals with the Crown Pacific matter will be sent to the Skagit Valley Herald today.
- B. Mr. Christensen advised that the first meeting of the CAC regarding the Coordinated Water System Plan will meet tomorrow with Economic Engineering Services, consultant, for an introduction and orientation meeting.
- C. Mr. Christensen stated that on March 3 the Western Washington Growth Management Hearings Board will hold a compliance hearing on the matters which were recently addressed regarding revisions to the urban growth areas and definition of legal lot of record.

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- D. Mr. Christensen spoke to a petition filed by the Friends of Skagit County raising five issues on the recently adopted Mineral Resource Overlay Ordinance.
- E. Mr. Christensen stated that the Sedro Woolley City Council will meet this Thursday to consider Department comments and revisions to the Interlocal Agreement. He advised that the County needs to have this Agreement in place by March 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- F. The Board was presented with a request to approve a formal request to the State Revolving Loan Fund to provide more funding for the repair of on-site sewage systems, available to low and moderate income individuals. The Board signed the appropriate paperwork.
- G. The draft of the Development Code was discussed, and the Department asked for the Board to submit written comments as soon as possible.
- H. Mr. Christensen advised the Board that the interim telecommunications ordinance has expired which amended the County's zoning ordinance and gave some predictability and certainty to what sites the County would encourage such siting. Consequently, a public hearing is needed to readopt this interim ordinance. After a brief discussion, Commissioner Wolden moved to approve a Call for Public Hearing in this matter for March 16, 1999 at 10:00 a.m. Commissioner Hart seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. **(Resolution No. 17331)**

Commissioner Hart was absent for the following agenda item due to a conflict with a previously-scheduled meeting.

**PROCLAMATION – EARLY CHILDHOOD AND FAMILY SUPPORT DAY – MARCH 20, 1999.**

Commissioner Wolden moved to approve the Proclamation declaring March 20, 1999 as Early Childhood and Family Support Day in Skagit County. Chairman Anderson seconded the motion, and it was approved with a unanimous vote.

**MISCELLANEOUS.**

- 1. Staff presented a Right of Way Easement with Cascade Natural Gas Corporation for the installation of a natural gas line into the Skagit County Fairgrounds. Commissioner Hart moved to approve the Right of Way Easement as presented. Commissioner Wolden seconded the motion, which passed with a unanimous vote. **(Contract No. 04281)**
- 2. Staff presented Amendment No. 1 to the Consolidated Contract between the State Department of Health and the Skagit County Health Department. This amendment would add \$13,592 to the reimbursement from the State for total maximum consideration in 1999 of \$384,398. Commissioner Wolden moved to approve Amendment No. 2 as presented. Commissioner Hart seconded the motion, and it passed with a unanimous vote. **(Contract No. 04201)**
- 3. Staff presented a Memorandum of Agreement with the Humane Society to enforce the civil aspects of Skagit County Code Chapter 7.06 relating to dangerous dogs. The County agrees to pay \$5,600 per month for the services rendered, with such payment increasing to \$6,200 per month effective January 1, 2000. The agreement is in effect from January 1, 1999 through December 31, 2000. Commissioner Wolden moved to approve the Agreement as presented by Staff. Commissioner Hart seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. **(Contract No. 04282)**

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4. Staff presented an Amendment to Personal Services Agreement with Skagit Rape Relief and Battered Women's Services extending the completion date of the original agreement from December 30, 1998 through June 30, 1999. Compensation remains the same at \$30,000 for the duration of the agreement. Commissioner Wolden moved to approve the Amendment as presented. Commissioner Hart seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. **(Contract No. 03962)**
5. Staff presented a Memorandum of Agreement with the Sedro Woolley Museum for tourism promotion utilizing hotel/motel taxes in 1999. The County will pay a maximum of \$1,000 in this regard during calendar year 1999. Commissioner Wolden moved to approve the Agreement as presented by Staff. Commissioner Hart seconded the motion, which passed with a unanimous vote. **(Contract No. 04283)**
6. Staff presented a Contract Amendment to a Personal Services Agreement with Cass Construction. This amendment would allow reimbursement of the permit fee of \$145.50 for remodeling done on behalf of the Sheriff's Office. Commissioner Wolden moved to approve the Amendment as presented. Commissioner Hart seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. **(Contract No. 04089)**
7. Staff presented a Professional Services Agreement with Island Building for emergency repairs to the Sinclair Island Dock totaling \$7,762, which includes \$562 in sales tax. Commissioner Wolden moved to approve the Agreement as presented by Staff. Commissioner Hart seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. **(Contract No. 04286)**
8. Staff presented a Memorandum of Agreement with CommonGround: The Dispute Resolution center of Skagit County, for calendar year 1999. Under this agreement, the County will pay CommonGround the sum of \$52,000 at the rate of \$4,333.33 each month. Commissioner Wolden moved to approve the Agreement as presented. Commissioner Hart seconded the motion, which passed with a unanimous vote. **(Contract No. 04285)**

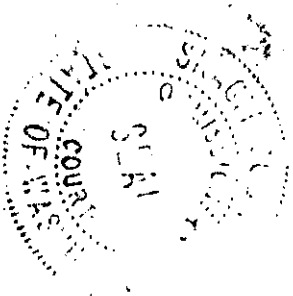
