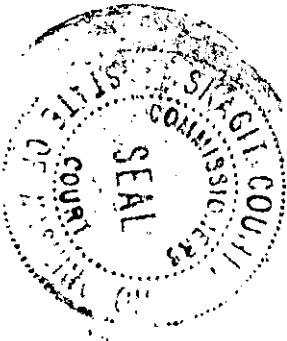
PRESENTATION BY THE AUDITOR OF THE 2000 PRELIMINARY BUDGET.

Kathy Hill, Skagit County Auditor, presented the Board with the budget books for the Year 2000 Skagit County Budget. She stated that there are misstated revenues due to the possibility of Initiative 695 passing. She commented further on the affects of labor negotiations on various departments. She reviewed other variables that affect the budget, stating that the Board's job of balancing the budget will be difficult. She reviewed specific figures regarding revenues, expenditures, and the resultant deficit.

Alicia Huschka, Budget Director, briefly reviewed the status of the General Fund in this preliminary budget.

Chairman Anderson made a motion to adjourn the proceedings. Commissioner Wolden seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.




