

**SKAGIT COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS
WEDNESDAY, JULY 24, 2002**

The Skagit County Commissioners met in special session on Wednesday, July 24, 2002, with Commissioners Don Munks, Kenneth A. Dahlstedt and Ted W. Anderson present.

DELIBERATION – AN INTERIM ORDINANCE READOPTING THE PROVISIONS OF INTERIM ORDINANCE NO. 17945, WHICH ADOPTED TOWN OF CONCRETE DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS ON AN INTERIM BASIS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED PORTION OF THE TOWN’S URBAN GROWTH AREA.

Kirk Johnson, Senior Planner, stated that pursuant to RCW 36.70A, Skagit County adopted a Comprehensive Plan by Ordinance No. 16550, which became effective June 1, 1997. The Comprehensive Plan designates urban growth areas throughout the County where urban development is encouraged and where adequate public facilities and services exist or can be provided in an efficient manner. The Ordinance has been renewed several times on a six-month basis.

The Skagit County Planning Commission held a public hearing on June 18, 2002, where it considered updates to the city and town development regulations, including those Concrete development regulations already adopted by Skagit County on an interim basis through Ordinance No. 17945. The Board of County Commissioners were unable to take action on that proposal by July 25, 2002, the deadline by which Interim Ordinance No. 17945 needed to be renewed or its provisions adopted on a permanent basis.

Based on that information, the Board suggested an Interim Ordinance be readopted for the Town of Concrete only, which would be effective for a period of six months from the date signed.

Commissioner Dahlstedt made a motion to approve an Interim Ordinance readopting the provisions of Interim Ordinance No. 17945, which adopted the Town of Concrete’s development standards on an interim basis for the unincorporated portion of the Town’s urban growth area. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. **(Resolution No. R20020265)**

ADJOURNMENT.

Commissioner Dahlstedt made a motion to adjourn the proceedings. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
