

**RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS  
SKAGIT COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
FRIDAY, AUGUST 27, 2004**

The Skagit County Commissioners met in special session on Friday, August 27, 2004, with Commissioners Ted W. Anderson and Don Munks present.

Commissioner Don Munks read an emergency Resolution that authorizes a rock quarry, owned by Charles Tewalt, et. al, to be relieved from their normal hours of operation. A state of emergency exists due to a rock blast, which buried tons of debris on top of the main transmission line for the City of Mount Vernon and surrounding areas. In order to facilitate repairs, it is necessary for the quarry to remove this material, which will require working around the clock and through the weekend.

Commissioner Munks motioned to approve the emergency Resolution, as outlined. The motion was seconded by Chairman Anderson, and carried. **(Resolution No. R20040293)**

**ADJOURNMENT.**

Commissioner Munks made a motion to adjourn the proceedings. Chairman Anderson seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
