***T 9:30 a.m. – 10:30 a.m.** Presentation – Deluxe Recycling Project Overview & Update

The Skagit County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, May 22, 2007, with Commissioners Sharon D. Dillon, Don Munks and Kenneth A. Dahlstedt present.

PRESENTATION – DELUXE RECYCLING PROJECT OVERVIEW & UPDATE.

Will Honea, Chief Civil Deputy Prosecutor, stated his concerns regarding Cimarron's transferring the proposed contract to Deluxe Recycling.

Steve Snell, Principal of Deluxe Recycling and Disposal, gave a PowerPoint presentation which explained the business plan and services of his company.

Commissioner Don Munks commented on the need to meet the intent of the Solid Waste Management Plan and explained the County's request for proposal process.

Commissioner Ken Dahlstedt stated concerns about the public interest and costs of handling hazardous waste.

Mike Anderson, Mayor of Sedro-Woolley, commented on Deluxe Recycling and Disposal's proposal as perhaps being a win-win situation. The property is zoned industrial and has had a mill on it for many years. Potentially, the site could attract another business that would be noisier and the City could do nothing about it. Mayor Anderson expressed the positive aspects of having the business located in Sedro-Woolley.

Chair Dillon explained the Board's desire to work with municipalities to provide the most cost effective system within the County.

ADJOURNMENT.

Commissioner Munks made a motion to adjourn the proceedings. Commissioner Dahlstedt seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
