

# Do You Need an Interpreter For Court?

Do you have a case in the Skagit County District Court? Do you have trouble speaking or understanding English?

You can ask for an interpreter to interpret in the courtroom for you, without cost to you.

## **IF YOU NEED AN INTERPRETER, THIS IS WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:**

- Fill out the form below and take it to the District Court office, located at 600 S. 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Public Safety Building. **Do this 2-5 days BEFORE your hearing. If you have more than one hearing, use additional forms.**
- If your hearing is cancelled or the date changes, you must **immediately tell the District Court** by calling (360) 336-9319 or in-person at the Court office located at 600 S. 3rd in the Public Safety Building. This will let the court cancel the interpreter.
