



THE SKAGIT DISASTER RELIEF HOTEL LODGING PROGRAM

Emergency Hotel Lodging for Skagit County Residents Displaced by Flooding

The Skagit Disaster Relief Hotel Lodging Program provides **short-term, emergency hotel stays** for individuals and households who are unable to safely return home due to **flood-related damage or displacement**. Referrals to this program are accepted only from vetted and confirmed referral partner agencies. This program is designed to support immediate housing stability while longer-term recovery or housing solutions are identified.

Program Eligibility

Clients Must:

- Reside in **Skagit County**
- Be displaced or unable to return to their primary residence due to **flood-related damage**.

This program is intended for short-term emergency lodging during active displacement.

How to Access the Hotel Lodging Program:

- To access a hotel room through this program, eligible individuals and households **must work with a trusted, vetted partner referral agency**, which will assist with eligibility verification and hotel placement.

Lodging stays are coordinated centrally - clients do not book their own rooms.

Important Client Responsibilities:

Clients are responsible for all hotel incidentals including:

- Room damages, Smoking Fees, Pet Fees
- Additional Services

Clients must provide a personal payment card for incidentals, or the referring organization may provide a card on the client's behalf.
