

Promulgation

The **Skagit County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan** dated September, 2003 is hereby adopted this 18th day of September, 2003, as the official natural hazards mitigation plan for the Upper Skagit Indian Tribe, the Swinomish Indian Tribal Community, Skagit County Dike District #12, and the governments of Skagit County and the cities/towns of Anacortes, Burlington, Concrete, Hamilton, La Conner, Lyman, Mount Vernon, and Sedro-Woolley. The participation in and adoption of a multi-jurisdictional pre-disaster mitigation plan shall not necessarily imply advocacy of, or support for, individual mitigation initiatives proposed by other participating jurisdictions, and the adoption of the plan by each jurisdiction shall be subject to limitations as set forth in each jurisdictions adoption resolution.




