Jurisdiction-Specific Information; Hazard Vulnerability Assessment and Proposed Mitigation Strategies

NOTE:

This section of the **Skagit County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan** contains jurisdictional-specific information regarding vulnerability to natural hazards and proposed mitigation strategies.

Each entity participating in the multi-jurisdictional process worked independently utilizing various locally-developed forms as well as the 20/20 Mitigation Software provided to Skagit County by the Washington State Military Department, Emergency Management Division to help assess their vulnerability to various natural hazards. This assessment process was made on a subjective basis considering past events and the best available information. In addition, each entity did their best to list mitigation strategies currently in place as well as identify new mitigation strategies and/or projects that would benefit their specific community.

The information contained in this section regarding vulnerability and mitigation strategies are specific to each participating Indian Tribe, jurisdiction, or special purpose district that participated in the development of this plan.

In addition, some communities that currently participate in the National Flood Insurance Program Community Rating System (CRS) elected to include jurisdictional-specific CRS-related information in this section of the plan.
