SECTION A - OPEN CLASS EXHIBITS

Open Class Exhibits are accepted by the fair from any adult or youth not affiliated with a 4-H club or FFA Chapter. Please refer to each Division for specific Division rules.

OPEN CLASS ENTRY DEADLINES ANIMALS:

Entries are due online at www.skagitcounty.net/fair by the 2nd Friday of July.

- INDOOR ENTRY DATES HAVE CHANGED FROM PREVIOUS YEARS DUE TO NEW FAIR SCHEDULE.
- ALL ENTRY DATES AND TIMES ARE LISTED ON THE SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES.

OPEN CLASS ENTRY RULES

Please read the General Rules and Regulations.

All exhibits must be the handwork of the registered exhibitor. All artworks must be original and not a photocopied reproduction. Every exhibit must have an entry tag with the exhibitor's name and age group.

An entry fee is not required for still life exhibits. There is an entry fee for animal exhibits. Please see specific animal divisions for the fee amount.

Superintendents reserve the right to refuse entries that are duplicates, not an original created by the exhibitor, entered in another division or otherwise inappropriate or unpleasing to the exhibit.

No person shall receive a free pass just because they have entered an exhibit. Open Class Animal Exhibitors may purchase an exhibitor's wristband, which allows them entry to the Fair to care for and feed their animals.

ALL STATIC (non-animal) exhibits may be picked up at 8 pm Sunday until 9 pm or 11 am – 5:30 pm the Monday after the Fair. NO EXHIBITS MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIRGROUNDS PRIOR TO 8 PM SUNDAY. Exhibitors who remove their exhibits from the fair before 8 pm Sunday will not receive premiums and may not be able to exhibit at the Skagit County Fair in the future. There will be no exceptions to this rule. Exhibitor Claim Tickets must be presented to pick up entries. Perishable exhibits will be disposed of at 9 pm Sunday.

Please read the Veterinary Regulations and Recommendations for all animal exhibits.

Each animal is restricted to 4 premium entries in type classes.

ALL ANIMALS must remain on the Fairgrounds until their designated release time. Exhibitors who remove their animals from the fair before the designated release time may be banned from entering exhibits in the fair the following year. There will be no exceptions to this rule.

All Exhibitors must register their exhibits online using online entry prior to bringing their exhibits to the fair. www.skagitcounty.net/fair.

Exhibitors must bring their exhibits to the fairgrounds by the entry deadline.
