

OPEN CLASS LOCAL PRODUCE

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This is a unique year for the Skagit County Fair and for the world. RULES

1. Entries with insects will not be accepted.
2. Entries need to be free of any soil and foreign objects.
3. Items in each class should be as uniform as possible.
4. 2 entries may be made in each class, but they must be different varieties.
5. Bring the correct number of items for each entry.
6. Judging by American System. Only first Blue, Red & White are paid premiums in each class.

VEGETABLES

Preparation:

Cabbage: Leave 1 set of leaves to be removed upon display.

Corn: Cut stem flush to ear. Leave silk attached. Judge will expose some kernels to determine quality and uniformity.

Cucumbers: Leave ½" stem, cut with knife.

Garlic: Cut roots to ½" and tops to 1 ½"

Green Onions: Leave tops.

Onions: Remove as few outer husks as necessary to make onion look clean and attractive, cut roots to ½" and tops to 1 ½".

Potatoes: Wash but do not scrub.

Rhubarb: Leave white root end, remove leaf, but show leaf fan (about 1" long) top end.

Root Vegetables: Snip tops to 1" length. Leave root attached. Wash but do not scrub.

Squash: Leave about 1" of stem. Wash.

Tomatoes: Pick with scissors. Leave stem ½" if possible.

REMEMBER: When entering vegetables, cleanliness, uniformity of size and color are the first criteria in judging.
