We keep regular (9 – 5 / M-F) hours at the address above, and are only at the Fairgrounds for events.

Because campsites at the Fair are a limited resource, Exhibitors who are involved in the care of animals overnight will have priority consideration to receive a campsite for applications received before May 19.

Please fill out and return this Fair Camping Application on or before May 19 (**Do NOT include payment**). Once space assignments are completed, you will be contacted by Fairgrounds staff by May 31st, 2017 with your space # and a camp invoice. You will then fill out a site specific reservation form and make full payment in advance.

We are once again using a flat fee structure for overnight camping this year (\$95-Dry Camping, \$130 Hookup). Campers will be allowed to drop off trailers starting on Monday, August 7th. All trailers/campers will need to be removed from the Fairgrounds property no later than 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 13th. Due to security reasons, Campers will not be allowed to stay overnight in their designated site until the night of Tuesday, August 8th. The last night campers will be allowed to stay in their designated site will be the night of Saturday, August 12th. Beginning Tuesday, August 8th, there will be security guards present on the grounds and at all camping gates; however Skagit County Fairgrounds is not responsible and/or liable for any loss or damage to your personal property at any time while on the Fairgrounds property.

GUIDELINES:

1. All Camping assignments will be handled by the Fairgrounds Office. Placement requests will be accommodated to the best of our ability.
2. Applications will only be accepted from the person who will be camping in the space provided and who will be the responsible party.
3. Because of limited space, **NO** awnings or tip outs are allowed.
4. All campers must have proof of paid admissions to the Fair to gain access to the camping area. **Only pre-approved vehicles will be admitted at the gate.**
5. **Only ONE automobile (including towing vehicle) may be parked in, or at, a camping site. Any vehicle blocking traffic or fire lanes will be towed at the owner's expense.**
6. **Dry Camping: \$95 flat fee, With Hookups: \$130 flat fee**

RULES OF CONDUCT:

1. The possession and/or use of alcoholic beverages or drugs, other than prescribed medication, are prohibited.
2. Smoking on Fairgrounds property at any location is prohibited.
3. Persons under 18 years of age **MUST** have an adult chaperone.
4. No animals/pets are allowed in the campsites and/or Fairgrounds (except service animals) unless they are being exhibited at the Fair.
5. Fire lanes must be kept open. Any vehicles in violation will be towed at the owner's expense.
6. Obscene and discriminatory language, disrespect of Fair staff, volunteers, other campers, exhibitors, vendors, contractors, etc., will result in immediate dismissal from the fairgrounds and forfeiture of premiums.
7. Damage to, or destruction of, property belonging to others is strictly prohibited. This includes tampering with or disconnecting water or electrical services from another campsite and may result in additional charges and/or immediate dismissal and forfeiture of premiums.
8. Quiet hours 10PM to 6AM
9. All Campers must comply with Title 9 Chapter 9.41 & 9.42 governs Skagit County Parks. These rules and regulations are strictly enforced.

The undersigned agree to save Skagit County, its officials, employees & agents harmless from any and all loss or damage occasioned to me or my property and to any third person or property by reason of any acts or omissions on part of Skagit County, its officials, employees & agents or any other parties, while storing personal vehicle(s) or camping unit and/or while camping on county property and will defend and pay the expense of defending any suit which may be commenced against Skagit County, its officials, employees & agents or any third person alleging injury by reason of such acts or omissions and will pay any judgment which may be obtained against Skagit County, elected officials, employees & agents, in such suit. I further acknowledge that I have read this statement in its entirety, and understand and agree to the terms of this hold harmless waiver, camping guidelines, and rules of conduct.
