WHEREAS, RCW 70.05.060(7) relating to the powers and duties of boards of health provides that such boards shall "establish fee schedules for issuing or renewing licenses or permits, or for such other services as are authorized by law and the rules and regulation of the State Board of Health; PROVIDED, That such fees for services shall not exceed the actual cost of providing any such services." and,

WHEREAS, it is advisable to revise fees for the Environmental Public Health Division to more closely reflect the actual cost for permits for food service establishments, solid waste facilities, on-site septic systems, and other fees including hourly charges; and,

WHEREAS, Skagit County Public Health clinics for immunization, communicable disease, family planning and supporting laboratory services are no longer operating and, therefore, the related Schedule of Charges does not apply; and,

WHEREAS, the Department Director recommends that the Schedule of Charges is adjusted as in the attached Proposed Public Health Schedule of Charges; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a Public Hearing will be called for January 29, 2019 beginning at 9:00 am or as soon thereafter as possible in the Board of County Commissioners Hearing Room, 1800 Continental Place, Mount Vernon, Washington, where oral and written testimony will be heard for or against the adoption of the Skagit County Public Health Schedule of Charges. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to publish a notice of public hearing.
