- 1. Complete Application
- 2. Must have and maintain a current registration with Washington State Office of the Secretary of State and Department of Revenue, as required by business type
- 3. Pass a written examination approved by the Health Officer
  - a. Level 1 O&M Provider
    - i. Must pass the WOSSA O&M Level 1 examination, or equivalent
  - b. Level 2 O&M Provider
    - i. Must pass the WOSSA O&M Level 2 examination, or equivalent, in addition to any product specific training requirements
- 4. Demonstrate any combination of training that is determined by the Health Officer to be equivalent to:
  - a. Level 1 O&M Provider
    - i. Four CEUs (32 credit hours) of Health Officer approved training;
    - ii. Thirty-Two hours of training related to the operation, monitoring, or maintenance of OSS within the preceding five years; or
    - iii. Two years of full-time equivalent experience providing OSS O&M services within the preceding five years
  - b. Level 2 O&M Provider
    - i. Eight CEUs (64 credit hours) of Health Officer approved training;
    - ii. Sixty-Four hours of training related to operation, monitoring, or maintenance of OSS within the preceding five years; or
    - iii. Four years of full-time equivalent experience providing OSS operation, monitoring, and maintenance services within the preceding six years; and
    - iv. Documented training and experience must include proficiency with mounds, drip irrigation, and company specific approval for individual proprietary systems
- 5. Pay all fees applicable for installer certification
