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Establishing a 2007 On-site Sewage Ordinance

Update and Public Outreach Citizens Advisory Committee

Whereas, RCW 70.05.060(3) provides that the Local Board of Health shall enact such local rules and regulations as are necessary in order to preserve, promote and improve the public health and provide for the enforcement thereof; and

Whereas, Chapter 246-272A WAC, for On-site Sewage systems was passed by the State Board of Health and became effective September 15, 2005 with a full implementation date of July 1, 2007; and

Whereas, Chapter 12.05 Skagit County Code (SCC) was last revised in 1997 and needs an update and revision to reflect Chapter 246-272A WAC; and

Whereas, Chapter 246-272A includes a provision that Skagit County, as one of the 12 Puget Sound Counties, adopt a Management Plan delineating the management and maintenance of on-site sewage disposal systems in Skagit County; and

Whereas, it is desirable to encourage public participation in the rule revision process via a Citizens Advisory Committee representing the diversity of opinions, needs and changing circumstances in Skagit County; and

Whereas, to ensure the Citizens Advisory Committee is a manageable size and broadly representative, the Board shall select representatives from fields such as the on-site sewage industry (designers, installers and/or operations and maintenance specialists), environmental conservation, citizen representation; real estate and development; and

Whereas, the Board of Health shall select, either from among those who volunteer in response to published invitations and notices, or by direct invitation, citizens who it believes will represent a variety of areas of interest, and actively engage a broad spectrum of citizens, civic groups, organizations, interests and agencies in the update process.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Board of County Commissioners hereby establishes the 2007 On-site Sewage Ordinance Update and Public Outreach Citizens Advisory Committee and hereby appoints the following individuals:

- 8. I sat on the original Rails to Trails Committee in the early to mid 1990's with John Arstad.


