



# Septic System Maintenance & Repair Rebate Program Application

Available for on-site sewage system (OSS) maintenance and repair work done on or after February 1, 2024 through December 31, 2026, or until funding is depleted, whichever comes first.

**Why would I need it?** Routine maintenance of septic systems helps prevent system failures. Risers make the septic system easier to inspect later. Routine maintenance and repairs help protect public health and improve water quality.

## OSS Operation and Maintenance Rebate Program

- Up to \$500 per property owner/parcel (within a 12-month period from date of last approved rebate):
  - Inspection – \$100
  - Pumping – \$100
  - New installation of lids & risers – up to \$200 (receipts required)
  - Lid replacement – up to \$50 each (max 4) (receipts required, \*photos)
  - Minor repairs – up to \$200 (receipts required)
    - Minor repairs include pump, baffle, or d-box replacement, system control repairs, and filter installation or repair. See website for more details. [www.skagitcounty.net/septic](http://www.skagitcounty.net/septic)

**Please Note: All services, excluding lid replacements completed by homeowners, must be completed by a Skagit County certified provider in order to qualify for the rebate. \*Homeowner lid replacements require photo submission with application. Homeowner inspections and repairs do not qualify.**

## How it works

To qualify and receive your rebate you must:

- Own a residence in Skagit County (commercial properties are not eligible)
- Complete the free Septics 101 class/quiz online (**required** within 6 years of application)

- Work must have been completed by a Skagit County certified provider (excluding homeowner lid replacements)
  - Provider list available online at [www.skagitcounty.net/septic](http://www.skagitcounty.net/septic)
- Submit the application and supporting documents to Skagit County Public Health
- Allow up to **two months** for rebates to be processed, checks will be sent to mailing address
