History: The Barn replaced a small shed that was originally on the property. The barn housed his small dairy herd. The roof was replaced in 1985. The 4th generation of the family currently lives on the property and uses the barn for storage.

History: The original property owner was John W. Hall. He had the barn built in 1915 by a man named 'Mr. Hopping'. The current owner's father, Wendell Leander, bought the property in 1934. He married in 1941 and built the home on the property. Leander milked registered Holstein cows until retiring in 1967. After that, he raised peas, corn and wheat. When Wendell passed on in 1995, the farm was leased to area farmers. Since 2000 the barn has been used to store sheaves of wheat, which is currently harvested in early August and then sold in December as a Scandinavian-style outdoor Christmas decoration.

History: This farm was part of the Rural Resettlement Division of the late 1930s. The barn was used as a dairy until the modern milking parlor was built in the early 1980s
