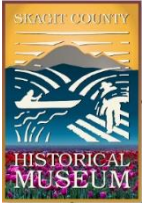


School Tour Reservation Form 2024-2025 School Year

No charge for teachers and chaperones.</p> <p>Description: Docent guided tour of the historical museum covering the history of our county. Our museum has permanent exhibits of the Coast Salish peoples, the industries of Skagit, and the daily life of settlers over a hundred years ago. Tour also includes the current East Wing exhibit when possible.</p>

Available: Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays between 9:30 am and 3:00 pm, by appointment only.

Duration: Tours generally last 3 hours.

Chaperones: Please prearrange for at least one chaperone per 6-8 students.

Price: \$5 per student. No charge for teachers and chaperones.

Description: General museum tour (see previous) followed by a presentation given by a local Coast Salish member providing more history and storytelling.

Skagit City School Experience

Location: Skagit City School, 17508 Moore Road, Mount Vernon, WA 98273

Available: Monday through Friday between 9:30 am and 3:00 pm, by appointment only.

Duration: Experience generally last 4.5 hours including a sack lunch break (bring your own lunch).

Chaperones: Please prearrange for at least one chaperone per 6-8 students.

Max indoor occupancy: 49.

Price: \$5 per student. No charge for teachers and chaperones.

Description: Share a fun filled day of Coast Salish and pioneer life workshops, games, and crafts held at our Skagit City School built in 1902. Includes 2-3 group workshops, and a craft activity.

7th Grade La Conner Now & Then Experience

Locations: Skagit County Historical Museum, Pioneer Park, walking tour of La Conner, and the cedar hats at the Welcoming Pavilion at swədəbš Park.

Available: Monday through Wednesday between 9:30 am and 3:00 pm, by appointment only.

Duration: Experience generally last 4.5 hours including a sack lunch break (bring your own lunch).

Chaperones: Please prearrange for at least one chaperone per 6-8 students.

Price: \$5 per student. No charge for teachers and chaperones. (requires your own bus transportation between sites during the experience)

Description: This experience is geared to 7th grade students. Students rotate through 4 experiences: a tour of the Skagit County Historical Museum, a craft project at the Pioneer Park, a Coast Salish presentation at the cedar hats at the Welcoming Pavilion at swədəbš Park, and a walking tour of La Conner (with possible stop at the Museum of Northwest Arts). Bring sack lunches to enjoy at the Pioneer Park!
