Fee Schedule Handout 2007**Utility Right-of-Way Permit Fees**

There is established the following fee structure for Utility Right-of-Way Permits:

Class A Work

Class A work has little or no effect on the right-of-way such as trenching the right-of-way for 25 lineal feet or less outside of the paved area, making an initial pavement cut of 4 square feet or less, or installing 5 or fewer new utility poles. Some examples of Class "A" work include stringing cables on utility poles; accessing existing manholes, handholes and vaults; installing short side services and hydrants while breaking 4 square feet or less of pavement; raising valves; trimming trees; providing cathodic protection; replacing above-ground meters, transformers, closures and pedestals; installing 2.5 by 2.5 feet or smaller splice boxes; and installing water sampling stations. No breaking of any PCC curb, gutter or sidewalk is allowed. The fee for each permit application for Class "A" work is set at \$95.00, said fee to provide reimbursement to the Skagit County Department of Public Works for the administrative and engineering costs and expenses of processing the Utility Right-of-Way Permit and inspecting the permitted work.

Class B Work

Class B work has a moderate effect on the right-of-way such as trenching between 25 and 100 linear feet of right-of-way, making an initial pavement cut of between 4 and 15 square feet, removing 2 or fewer panels of PCC sidewalk and associated curb and gutter, plowing cable outside roadway prism, installing more than 5 new utility poles, or replacing any utility poles. Some examples of Class "B" work includes installing short side utility services while disturbing between 4 and 15 square feet of pavement, pushing under a road, installing underground vaults, and constructing splice pits. The fee for each permit application for Class "B" work is set at \$280.00, said fee to provide reimbursement to the Skagit County Department of Public Works for the administrative and engineering costs and expenses of processing the Utility Right-of-Way Permit and inspecting the permitted work.

Class C Work

Class C work has a major impact on the right-of-way such as constructing any CRP related work, trenching 100 lineal feet or more in the right-of-way, making an initial pavement cut of 15 square feet or more, removing more than 2 panels of PCC sidewalk and associated curb and gutter, plowing cable inside roadway prism, or attaching to any bridge structure. Some examples of Class "C" work include constructing a main line or any open cut road crossing. The fee for each permit application for Class "C" work is set at \$740.00, said fee to provide reimbursement to the Skagit County Department of Public Works for the administrative and engineering costs and expenses of processing the Utility Right-of-Way Permit and inspecting of the permitted work.

Pavement Cutting

Skagit County promotes a coordinated planning effort between the Department of Public Works and the franchised utility to minimize the need for cutting of pavement which is less than 36 months old. The fee for permission to cut pavement which is less than 36 months old is established at \$20.00 per linear foot of disturbed pavement.

Skagit County Permit and Fees for Oversize Vehicles

These are new fees and if adopted will be implemented in 2007

A permit is required for all overweight loads on the County roadway system

Minimum fee for each Overweight Permit \$14.00

The following overweight fees will be assessed if the applicant does not have an overweight permit from Washington State Department of Transportation.

Collection Truck Fees

Continuous operation of a two or three axel collection truck, actually engaged in the collection of solid waste or recyclables, or both for one year with an additional:

Up to 6,000 lbs On Rear Axle of 2-Axle Truck.	\$42.00*
Up to 8,000 lbs On Tandem Axles of 3-Axle Truck.	\$42.00*

*per thousand pounds (annual permit only)

Fixed Load Fees

Continuous operation of 3-Axle fixed load vehicle 65,000 lbs. Maximum for a period not to exceed 1 month.	\$70.00
Continuous operation of 4-Axle fixed load vehicle 86,000 lbs. Maximum for a period not to exceed 1 month.	\$90.00

Farm Implement Fees

A farm implement 16 feet wide or less does not require a permit when traveling on the County roadway system.

A farm implement permit is required for implements over 16 feet wide but less than 20 feet wide for one year.	\$0.00
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
