# Skagit HOME Consortium Substantial Amendments to 2015-2017 Consolidated Plan, 2016 Annual Action Plan, and Citizen Participation Plan

# 1. Amendments to 2015-2017 Consolidated Plan

\$130,000 of funds will be reallocated from Affordable Homeowner Development to Affordable Rental Housing Development. The Consortium expects this to add an additional 5 units of rental housing to the region's affordable housing stock. The Consortium expects to assist 5 fewer homebuying households as a result of this allocation shift. In addition to reallocating the funds, goals, priorities, and objective references throughout the Consolidated Plan document will be amended

#### 2. Amendment to 2016 Annual Action Plan

\$92,578 of funds will be reallocated from Affordable Homeowner Development to Affordable Rental Housing Development. The Consortium expects this to add an additional 3 units of rental housing to the region's affordable housing stock. The Consortium expects to assist 3 fewer homebuying households as a result of this allocation shift. In addition to reallocating the funds, goals, priorities, and objective references throughout the Consolidated Plan document will be amended

### 3. Amendment to 2017 Annual Action Plan

\$37,422 of funds will be reallocated from Affordable Homeowner Development to Affordable Rental Housing Development. The Consortium expects this to add an additional 2 units of rental housing to the region's affordable housing stock. The Consortium expects to assist 2 fewer homebuying households as a result of this allocation shift. In addition to reallocating the funds, goals, priorities, and objective references throughout the Consolidated Plan document will be amended.

## 4. Amendment to Citizen Participation Plan

The Citizen Participation Plan will be amended to include the following new stakeholder categories:

- Broadband stakeholders: public and private organizations including broadband internet service providers, and organizations engaged in narrowing the digital divide.
- Community/Disaster Resiliency stakeholders: agencies whose primary responsibilities include
  the management of flood prone areas, public land, or water resources, and emergency
  management agencies.
