Substantial Amendments to 2015-2017 Consolidated Plan, 2016 Annual Action Plan, and Citizen Participation Plan

1. Amendments to 2015-2017 Consolidated Plan

\$130,000 of funds will be reallocated from Affordable Homeowner Development to Affordable Rental Housing Development. The Consortium expects this to add an additional 5 units of rental housing to the region's affordable housing stock. The Consortium expects to assist 5 fewer homebuying households as a result of this allocation shift. In addition to reallocating the funds, goals, priorities, and objective references throughout the Consolidated Plan document will be amended

2. Amendment to 2016 Annual Action Plan

\$92,578 of funds will be reallocated from Affordable Homeowner Development to Affordable Rental Housing Development. The Consortium expects this to add an additional 3 units of rental housing to the region's affordable housing stock. The Consortium expects to assist 3 fewer homebuying households as a result of this allocation shift. In addition to reallocating the funds, goals, priorities, and objective references throughout the Consolidated Plan document will be amended

3. Amendment to 2017 Annual Action Plan

\$37,422 of funds will be reallocated from Affordable Homeowner Development to Affordable Rental Housing Development. The Consortium expects this to add an additional 2 units of rental housing to the region's affordable housing stock. The Consortium expects to assist 2 fewer homebuying households as a result of this allocation shift. In addition to reallocating the funds, goals, priorities, and objective references throughout the Consolidated Plan document will be amended.

4. Amendment to Citizen Participation Plan

The Citizen Participation Plan will be amended to include the following new stakeholder categories:

- Broadband stakeholders: public and private organizations including broadband internet service providers, and organizations engaged in narrowing the digital divide.
- Community/Disaster Resiliency stakeholders: agencies whose primary responsibilities include the management of flood prone areas, public land, or water resources, and emergency management agencies.
