
Housing Instability Insights Skaqit County - June 2025



What is Coordinated Entry?

Coordinated Entry is a system used in Skagit County and other communities to ensure that all people experiencing homelessness are guickly and fairly connected to limited housing resources based on their level of need.



When someone leaves housing or services part of the homeless response system, the next place they go is called an exit destination. Tracking this helps us understand how our response system is working.
