Review of previous meeting minutes- Previous meeting minutes were reviewed (meeting date 11-18-2023). Trisha Logue made a motion to approve the minutes. This was seconded by Melinda Miller. Meeting minutes are approved.

Financial reconciliation documents- The financial documents prepared by Michele Long and Elizabeth Christiansen regarding jail expenses, revenue, days served, balance sheet, and sales tax revenue (previously distributed via email to the group) brought no comments or objections from the committee members.

Jail Operations update- (Don Marlow)- Staffing issues are still prevalent. The jail is currently 17 people short. Due to the shortage, one jail pod has been closed down, and time out breaks from cells has been shortened to 2 hours from 4 hours. There has been a jump in applications to work at the jail due to the current recruiting bonus.

The current average daily population is 216. This number tends to trend up as we come into summer. The goal is to be fully staffed by September. The average daily population will be 250-290 when staffing is full. The population may be partially be based on the Blake decision currently being discussed in the state legislature.
