# **January Meeting Minutes**

# **Pending Property Review**

Kara said the 2014/2015 pending applications are in various states of process and the Board of County Commissioners signed the first easement this week.

# Ranking

Today the CFAC will discuss FLP applicants #184, #190, and #191. Kara mentioned that the landowner for #184 has given the ok for the County to apply for the next round of State Recreation & Conservation funding.

# The CFAC discussed:

- a) How ranking might be adjusted throughout the year depending on situational score changes
- b) Point assignments for original, core, and edge. Kara mentioned discussing core and edge scores make a good triage conversation for original score points
- c) Threat of conversion (urgency of sale) differences between applicant #184 and #191; the immediate threat for #184 is not as great as #191, though both will receive the same points.
- d) Kara said leveraging funds could be a challenge for #190 due to the existing protected property. This will be amendment to the original easement to allow for an additional development right to the existing development right on this property.
