Between any cultivar or any one of the 9 types in Group 13 or any other cultivars of the same kind: 1 mile with a 1 1/4 mile red zone.

Siberian kale does not cross pollinate with any cultivar of collard, kale, cabbage Brussels sprouts, cauliflower, broccoli, or kohlrabi. However, Siberian kale should be isolated 2 miles from any cultivar of rutabaga.

Parenthesis ( ) indicates Red Zone mileage. Agreement between seed companies required. See other side for definition of Red Zones.

Check Hybrid Cabbage isolation with field representative. Oregon may have greater isolation distances because of smaller acreage and a larger land area.

- Group 2** (Late pointed) Late White Offenham

- Group 4** (Midseason round) Medium Copenhagen, Glory, Midseason Market, Ferry's Round Dutch, Marion Market, Globe, Badger Market, Greenback
- Group 5** (Late round - Danish) Danish Ballhead, Penn State Ballhead, Wisconsin Ballhead, Wisconsin Hollander #8
- Group 6** (Flat or Drumhead) Stein's Flat Dutch, Premium Late Flat Dutch, All Season, Wisconsin All Season, Brunswick, Succession
- Group 7** (Winter storage type) Houston Evergreen, Langendijker Type, Green Winter
- Group 8** Red open pollinated cabbage
- Group 9** Savoy open pollinated cabbage
- Group 10** Red hybrid cabbage
- Group 11** Green hybrid cabbage
- Group 12** Savoy hybrid cabbage

Between any cultivar in group 1 and 2 and any cultivar of cabbage, Brussels sprouts, cauliflower, broccoli and kohlrabi--5 miles.

Siberian kale does not cross pollinate with any cultivar of collard, kale, cabbage, Brussels sprouts, cauliflower, broccoli, or kohlrabi. However, Siberian kale should be isolated 2 miles from any cultivar of rutabaga.
